How might we equip teachers so that students can reach their full potential and contribute positively to society? How can honours education foster talent? How can research help us to understand and respond to these questions? The goal of the conference is to strengthen honours education and research by exchanging knowledge drawn from research & practice. ### **Summer Institute on Tolerance, Diversity and the Holocaust starts for third edition**

From June 10, fifteen US honours students and seven Dutch honours students will work together in a 2.5-week, international, interdisciplinary summer program around the history of the Holocaust, and specifically of Camp Westerbork in the Netherlands. The program is organized annually by Hanze University of Applied Sciences' Honours College in cooperation with Memorial Center Camp Westerbork and the Honours College of Windesheim University of Applied Sciences. Students will visit Holocaust museums and sites in Amsterdam and Berlin. A connection will be made to contemporary issues through visits to the International Criminal Court and Humanity House in the Hague and through readings and assignments during the program.
